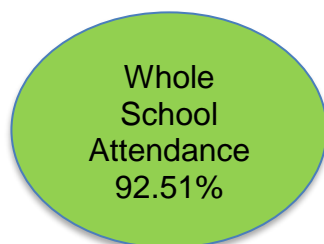
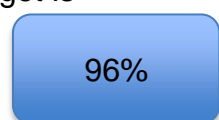
Parking
