Parking

Thank you to the majority of parents who park considerately every day. We open from 8.30am for children which has alleviated some of the parking and we have also extended the carpark to ensure that staff are not parked on the roads. Unfortunately, there are 1 or 2 people who do not park considerately and when challenged, use foul language in front of the children towards others. We ask that all members of the school community are **Ready Respectful Safe** so that we are positive role models for the children.

From September, Warwickshire will begin providing enhanced parking enforcement support around a number of primary priority schools. Our school is included in this first tranche which is planned to go live in the Autumn term. The primary focus will be to deter and prevent illegal parking on school 'keep clear' (zig-zag) markings, and the double yellow lines supporting the school aiming to educate drivers and to ensure safer access for children and families. Vehicles parked in contravention will be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN).

Improvement works have been completed ahead of the September rollout including each set of zig-zag markings which are now clearly visible and accompanied by appropriate signage indicating the parking restrictions which now meet legal standards.
