

## What training do the teachers have?

The SENCo's job is to support the class teacher in planning for children with SEND.

The school has a training plan for all staff to improve the teaching and learning of all. This includes whole school training on SEND issues such as ASC and Speech and Language difficulties.

Individual teachers and support staff attend training courses run by outside agencies that are relevant to the needs of specific children in their class e.g from the Specialist Teacher Service, the Hearing Impairment Team.

There are also teaching assistants in school who have attended training courses on specific needs who support and advise other adults in school about the most effective strategies to use to support individual children within school.
