Attendance

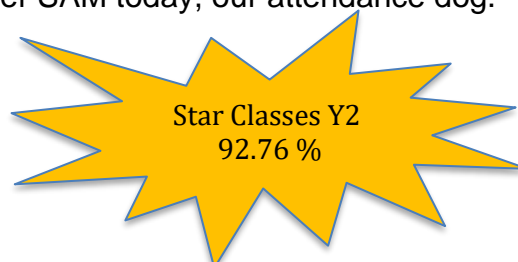
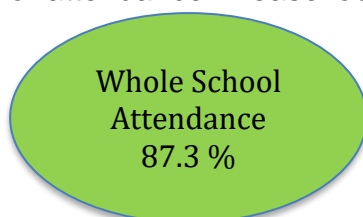
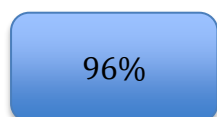
We at Nursery Hill Primary School closely monitor all children's attendance. If we feel concerned, we will contact the County Council for support. You may be contacted either by phone or by letter to discuss any obstacles to regular attendance. However, if attendance does not improve, a meeting may need to be set up with parents to find solutions. All pupils with attendance levels of below 90% will be requested to supply medical evidence for absences. Continued unauthorised absence could lead to a referral to the Warwickshire Attendance Service.

If your child is suffering from a minor ailment such as a cold or a cough please consider sending them to school. We will always send them home if they feel they are too unwell to be here. Keep in contact with us every day to keep us aware of what is wrong and seek advice as to whether your child could even do part of the school day. For absences of 3 days or more, please ensure you seek medical advice and provide a copy for the medical appointment to our school office team in order to authorise absences as illness.

With regards to holiday during term time, we do ask that you please ensure you arrange holidays outside of term time – holidays will only ever be authorised by our Headteacher in exceptional circumstances. **Please consider when pupils take holidays without notifying the school. It can cause stress to our pupils and their friends as they feel pressured into being dishonest.** Should you wish to take your child out of school during term time, please complete the Leave of Absence form and return to the office.


